Dry eye... but why?

What's causing your dry eye symptoms?

Do your dry eyes still feel **gritty, rough, or tired** no matter what you do? Do you experience vision that changes throughout the day?

There are 2 types of dry eye:



Too much tear evaporation

which contributes to dry eye in about **9 out of 10** people.



Not making enough tears

which is a less common type of dry eye.

Sometimes you can have a combination of both types of dry eye.

What does dry eye feel like?

With too much tear evaporation, it's common to experience:



Needing to blink to clear your vision



Vision that fluctuates



Symptoms that get worse throughout the day

Why do my dry eyes feel watery?




Too much tear exception? Ohh no

Everyone's tears evaporate. But when you have **evaporative dry eye**, your tears escape too quickly—more than what's considered normal. This leaves eyes feeling **dry, rough, and gritty**.

Why too many tears evaporate

On the outside of your eye, there is something called the "**tear film**." It's made up of 3 layers:



In healthy eyes, the oily layer helps to keep the tears from drying out.

With evaporative dry eye, **the oily layer isn't effective**, and it allows too many tears to evaporate.

A closer look

Little glands called **meibomian glands** make this oily layer on the surface of the eye that prevents the watery tears underneath from evaporating.

In evaporative dry eye, the meibomian glands don't work as they should and the oily layer becomes damaged.

This damage leads to too much **tear evaporation**.

Causes of too much tear evaporation



Factors that contribute to evaporative dry eye



Screen time (blinking less)

When you concentrate on certain activities, you blink less often without noticing. A study showed when looking at a screen, you may only blink 7 times per minute. Reading a book, you may only blink 10-15 times per minute. When you aren't blinking as much as you should, more tears evaporate.



Meibomian gland dysfunction

When the meibomian glands (the glands responsible for making the oily layer on the surface of the eye) get clogged or don't work properly, the tear film doesn't form properly. It's the leading cause of too much tear evaporation.



Certain medications

Antihistamines, decongestants, acne medication, antidepressants, heart medication, and diabetes medication can affect the tear film.



Inflammation

Inflammation in dry eye is very common. When too much tear evaporation causes damage to the surface of your eye, it can also cause inflammation. This can make damage worse, creating a vicious cycle of worsening dry eye signs and symptoms.



The environment

Wind, smoke, air conditioning, or dry air in the environment can speed up evaporation.



Aging

Dry eyes can be a natural part of aging.

Finding the right treatment

Is MIEBO right for me?

If you've tried over-the-counter treatments, prescriptions, or procedures and are still looking for relief, maybe it's time to try something different. Consider asking your doctor about MIEBO.

Other eye drops may add tears or increase the number of tears you make. But for about 9 out of 10 people with dry eye, the cause, in part, is too much tear evaporation. This means that other drops alone may not be enough.

How Micholand works

When you place a drop of MIEBO in your eye, it **spreads evenly and quickly** to form a protective layer. This reduces evaporation, so you can keep more of your own tears.

MIEBO is the first and only prescription eye drop that directly targets too much tear evaporation.

Protective layer

Mimics the way the protective outer layer of your own tear film prevents evaporation.

Long lasting

Helps form a lasting barrier that fights tear evaporation to improve the signs and symptoms of dry eye with continued use.

Preservative free

How Miebo^{*} may help

In clinical studies, MIEBO was shown to significantly* reduce:



Signs of dry eye

With continued use of MIEBO, doctors saw improvements in the damage on the surface of the eye.



Symptoms of dry eye

People in the studies felt their eye dryness significantly improved.

Relief in as little as 2 weeks

In the studies, doctors checked the signs and symptoms of dry eye after 2 weeks, and again after 8 weeks. Patients saw significant improvement at both checkpoints while they were continuing to use MIEBO.

*MIEBO was studied against saline in 2 clinical trials of more than 1200 patients who were treated 4 times per day.

Side effects with MIEBO are uncommon

MIEBO is a prescription eye drop approved by the FDA. Because it's a prescription, it was studied in-depth in patients, unlike over-the-counter artificial tears.

The safety of MIEBO was studied in more than 600 people in 2 clinical trials that lasted 57 days (GOBI and MOJAVE). **No serious side effects were seen in either study.** The data below is an average of the studies.

- - **0 serious side effects.** No one treated with MIEBO experienced serious side effects.

Follow these simple steps to use MIEBO:

Get ready.

If you wear contacts, take them out before using MIEBO and wait at least 30 minutes after using MIEBO to put them back in.

Get set.

To prime the bottle before you use it:

- Unscrew the cap
- Squeeze the bottle
- Turn it upside down
- Release the pressure

Go with MIEBO.

Keeping the bottle upside down, move it above your eye. Then, gently squeeze the bottle to release 1 drop.

Repeat the steps to prime the bottle and release 1 drop in your other eye.

Use daily as directed. For best results, continue using MIEBO

as directed.
